

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE NORTH BOUNDARY,
T. 33 N., R. 18 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

S. $89^{\circ} 21'$ W., along the N. bdy. of sec. 4.

Over rolling land, covered with sagebrush and bunchgrass.

24.00 Begin ascent; asc. 130 ft. over E. slope.

35.00 Spur, slopes N.; desc. gradually over W. slope.

40.15 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 33, monumented with an iron stone, 18x10x3 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the N. face. This corner will now refer to sec. 4 only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

bury the original corner stone alongside the iron post.

S. $89^{\circ} 59'$ W., beginning new measurement.

Over rolling land; desc. 130 ft. over W. slope.

40.29 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, monumented with an iron stone, 26x16x8 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 2 notches on the W. edge and 4 notches on the E. edge. This corner will now refer to secs. 4 and 5 only.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
