

COMPLETION SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 33 N., R. 18 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS	set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 22 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post. From this corner, the cor. of secs. 21 and 28, bears N. 0° 36' E., 0.67 chs. dist. Land, rolling. Soil, sandy clay and rocky. Undergrowth, sagebrush and bunchgrass.
	Point for the E. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 29, is at midpoint and on the W. bdy. of sec. 28. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
