

RETRACEMENT OF THE NEVADA-CALIFORNIA STATE LINE
BETWEEN MILE POST NOS. 107 AND 109

CHAINS	
	Mile Post No. 107, monumented with a basalt stone, 16x8x8 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with C on the W. face, NEV on the E. face and O on the N. face. At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 6 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. MP 107 CAL NEV 1973 deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 6 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post. S. 0° 05' E., along the 108th Mile. Over rolling land, covered with medium sagebrush and bunchgrass; asc. slightly over W. slope. 5.00 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 170 ft. over S. slope. 31.50 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SE.; asc. 20 ft. over N. slope. 35.81 The closing corner of secs. 29 and 32, T. 30 N., R. 18 E., hereinafter described. Ascend 30 ft. over N. slope. 40.50 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 160 ft. over S. slope. 80.00 Mile Post No. 108, monumented with a basalt stone, 14x8x6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 108 on the N. face, CAL on the W. face, NEV on the E. face and 1872 L 120 on the S. face. At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 6 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. MP 108 CAL NEV 1973 deposit the original stone and set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 6 ins. in the ground, alongside the iron post.
