

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE WEST BOUNDARY
(RUBY VALLEY GUIDE MERIDIAN)

	N. 0° 23' E., along the W. bdy. of sec. 6. Over mountainous land, covered with sagebrush and bunch grass. 38.00 Trail road, bears NE. and SW., leave mountainous land, bears NE. and SW.; enter rolling land. 39.43 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T37N R56E ¼ S 6 1975 set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, alongside the iron post. 78.86 The cor. of Tps. 37 and 38 N., R. 56 E., monumented with a granite stone, 16x8x8 ins., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, mkd. with 6 notches on N., S. and E. edges. At the corner point Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. T37N R56E S 31 S 6 T37N 1975 deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, alongside the iron post.
