		GENERAL DESCRIPTION
		The area resurveyed within Township 29 North, Range 63 East, is gently rolling to rolling. The elevation is about 6,000 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam to sandy clay and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and crested wheat grass.
		Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the Township is provided by improved and unimproved dirt road. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
