

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EIGHTH STANDARD PARALLEL,
THROUGH RANGE 69 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.

From this corner, the standard ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 35, T. 41 N., R. 68 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the Eighth Standard Parallel North, through a portion of Range 68 East, T. 41 N., R. 68 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears S. 87° 53' W., 123.45 chs. dist.

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by

From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, Tps. 40 N., Rs. 69 and 70 E., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 40 N., R. 70 E., executed under Group No. 637.

N. 0° 08' W., bet. secs. 25 and 30.

Over gently rolling land, covered with medium greasewood, scattered sagebrush and native grass.

Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 30, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
