At the corner point Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T33N R54E S 35 S 36 1987 Deposit the decayed remains of the original wooden post alongside the stainless steel post and rebuild the mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, W. of cor.
