

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE NORTH BOUNDARY,

CHAINS	from which the 1935 bearing trees A jeffrey pine, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 6° 15' W., 8 lks. dist., with a healed blaze at base. (Record, N. 5° W.) An incense cedar, 26 ins. diam., bears S. 11° 15' W., 59 lks. dist., with a healed blaze at base. (Record, S. 13¼° W.) and the remains of an unrecorded bearing tree A cut cedar stump, 36 ins. diam., 3 ft. high, bears N. 64° 00' E., 99 lks. dist., with the marks BT visible on SE. face.
