

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
TOWNSHIP 16 NORTH, RANGE 19 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS	
	At the corner point Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground with a magnet at base, and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. T16N R19E ¼ S 5 S 4 1986 from which A Washoe pine, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 71° 30' E., 91½ lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S4 BT. A granite boulder, 7X4X2 ft. above ground, bears N. 49° 00' W., 11½ lks. dist. to cross chiseled on SE face, mkd. BX0. Cor. is located on gentle SE slope in scattered Washoe pine and brush. N. 3° 24.5' E., beginning new measurement.
4.75	Rounded spur, slopes gently S. 84° E.
11.85	Center of foundation of remains of Shingler Weavers cabin, 15X20 lks., bears EAST, 299 lks. dist.
13.45	Rounded spur, slopes gently E.
16.45	Head of ravine, drains N. 75° E.
26.45	Rounded spur, slopes N. 80° E.
28.99	Jeep trail, 15 lks. wide, bears S. 88° E. and N. 88° W.
39.644	The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above an embedded mound of stone, 2 ft. diam., with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the 1935-45 dependent resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 17 N., R. 19 E., executed under Group Nos. 156 and 332, from which the 1935 bearing trees A jeffrey pine, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 31° 30' E., 158 lks. dist., with a healed blaze. (Record, N. 32° E., 150 lks.)
