	Over mountainous land, through timber.
19.59	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S. 50° E., in alders.
23.99	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S. 55° E., in alders.
29.17	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. 85° E.
36.66	Rocky gulch, drains S. 68° E.
39.536	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6, determined at record dist. from the original bearing trees
	A jeffrey pine, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 45° 45' E., 38 lks. dist., with a healed blaze. (Record, S. 40° E.)
	A jeffrey pine, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 9° 45' W., 34 lks. dist., with a healed blaze, cut into blaze, chaining notch and marks BT visible. (Record, S. 21° W.)
	At the corner point
	Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground with a magnet at base, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
