

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 16 N., R. 18 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Chains

Cor. is located on timbered SE slope with Jeffrey pine and scattered white fir.

From the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, on the E bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 20 ins. above ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the 1986 resurvey record, from which the remains of the original bearing trees

A fir stump, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 19 1/2° E., 117 lks. dist., mkd. with scribe marks BT and a chaining notch visible on open blaze. (1861 Record, S. 20°30' E.)

A stump hole (with fir bark ring, 48 ins. diam.), bears S. 78° W., 70 lks. dist., no marks visible.

No evidence was found for the record NE bearing trees (N. 15°30' E., 122 lks. and N. 33°30' E., 120 lks.), but the remains of an old bearing tree, possibly dating to the original survey

A stump hole, bears N. 38 1/2° W., 108 lks. dist., with remains of fir stump alongside, 55 ins. diam., with scribe marks BT and chaining notch visible on portion of exposed blaze.

A granite boulder, 3 x 6 x 3 ft. high, bears N. 47°15' E., 31 lks. dist., mkd. BXO on N face, 2 ft. above ground.

A red fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 61 1/2° E., 86.5 lks. dist., with scribe marks X at breast height and XBT at base.

A granite boulder, 2 1/2 x 5 x 2 1/2 ft. high, bears S. 16°15' W., 18 lks. dist., mkd. BXO on S face, 1 ft. above ground.

A red fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 89° W., 136.5 lks. dist., with scribe marks X at breast height and XBT at base.

Cor. is located on steep E slope among scattered fir timber, brush, and boulder outcroppings.
