

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 16 N., R. 18 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Chains

A western white pine, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 8 1/2° W., 170 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground with a magnet at base, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit the iron rod alongside the stainless steel post.

Cor. is located on moderate W slope in scattered pine and juniper timber.

N. 89°46'10" W., beginning new measurement.

Intersect the California-Nevada State Line, at a point N. 0°17'00" E., 33.452 chs. dist. from Milepost 188, hereinbefore described.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, Nevada.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground with a magnet at base, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
