CHAINS 40.029	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a DEEP-1 magnetic marker, with brass cap mkd. T16N R34E S 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ ——— S 9 1991 Set a steel fence post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.
80.058	The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, monumented with a stainless steel post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 16 N., R. 34 E., executed under Group No. 695. Land, gently rolling. Soil, sandy clay loam. Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale, rabbitbrush and native grass.
40.000	N. $0^{\circ}00.3'$ E., bet. secs. 4 and 5. Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth. Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock, over a DEEP-1 magnetic marker, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd. T16N R34E S $5\frac{1}{4}$ 4 1991
80.000	Point for the $80 \frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a DEEP-1 magnetic marker, with brass cap mkd. $\frac{1}{16}$ S $5\frac{1}{16}$ S 4 80 1991 Set a steel fence post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post.
