	From the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of the east boundary of T. 15 N., R. 30 E., executed under Group No. 181. Add the marks 1991 to the brass cap. N. 89°53.5' W., bet. secs. 24 and 25. Over rolling land, through scattered shadscale, greasewood, rabbitbrush, Brigham tea and native grass.
19.979	Point for the E $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of secs. 24 and 25. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2$\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground, over a DEEP-1 magnetic marker, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd. S 24 E $\frac{1}{16}$ ——— S 25 1991
39.958	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 24 and 25, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of the subdivision of T. 15 N., R. 30 E., executed under Group No. 181. Add the marks T15N R30E 1991 to the brass cap. From the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 10 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of the east boundary of T. 15 N., R. 30 E., executed under Group No. 181. Add the marks 1991 to the brass cap. West, bet. secs. 13 and 24.
