Beginning at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above the ground, and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the south boundary of T. 17 S., R. 51 E., executed under Group No. 433. N. 89°55'50" W., bet. secs. 6 and 31. Over gently rolling land. 20.037 Point for the E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31. POINT NOT MONUMENTED. 30.00 Ascend low rocky hill. 40.074 The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, 5 ft. diam., 1 1/2 ft. high, on a rocky ledge, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the south boundary of T. 17 S., R. 51 E., executed under Group No. 433. POINT NOT MONUMENTED. 38.956 The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the subdivisional lines of T. 17 S., R. 51 E., executed under Group No. 433, with a mound of stone, 4 ft. diam., 2 ft. high, W. of cor.
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
