	GENERAL DESCRIPTION The lands included in the survey are located in Nye County, Nevada, approximately 20 miles northwest of Pahrump, Nevada, and 4 miles northeast of the Nevada-California state line in Amargosa Valley on the Ash Meadows National Wildlife Refuge. The area is nearly level and slopes gradually to the southwest with no distinctive drains. The area is covered with scattered sagebrush and mesquite. Prior to the establishment of the refuge, the areas usage was farming, ranching and mining. There is very little remaining evidence of farming or ranching. Mining activity is limited to sec. 24, where there is a refinery on private property with ore being hauled to the mill located in California. The elevation of the area is approximately 2200 feet above sea level.
