

SURVEY OF THE WEST BOUNDARY,
T. 15 S., R. 47 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS	From the cor. of Tps. 14 and 15 S., Rs. 46 and 47 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the S. bdy., T. 14 S., R. 47 E., executed under Group No. 368, with a mound of stone, 3 ft. diam., 1 1/2 ft. high, E. of the cor. From this corner, an iron pipe, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above the ground, no record found, bears N. 3°23'30" E., 0.7 lks. dist. SOUTH, bet. secs. 1 and 6.
40.000	Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd. T15S R46E R47E 1/4 S 1 S 6 2022
80.000	Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd. T15S R46E R47E S 1 S 6 ----- S12 S 7 2022
40.000	SOUTH, bet. secs. 7 and 12. Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 12. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, over a plastic-encased magnet, in a supporting mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd. T15S R46E R47E 1/4 S12 S 7 2022
