History of earlier surveys contained in field notes.

Dependent Resurvey of the Coast and Geodetic Survey boundary line between the States of California and Nevada was executed by Roger F. Wilson, October 20 to 22, 1953, under special instructions for Group 267, California, dated March 3, 1931.

Independent resurvey of the north, west, and east boundaries and the survey of the south boundary and subdivisional lines and the metes-and-bounds survey of tracts, executed by Roger F. Wilson and Edward D. Lewis, October 12 to November 12, 1953, under supplemental special instructions for Group 251, Nevada, dated October 21, 1953.
